[NHS Kernow](#) [2] used their funding for the training of Living Well facilitators who are supporting front-line practitioner teams to co-design and develop integrated working across health, social care and the voluntary sector in several localities. The Living Well approach is a key element of Cornwall's Sustainability and Transformation Plan. System Leadership Training has taken place for 16 clinicians across the system.
